Prascher Dasher Oktoberfest 5K

The race will start West of Beaver Valley Elementary School running South and around the Watrous Park trail back to Mill Street. Continuing East by Beaver Valley along Mill St and onto the walking path, following the path into the Sunset North neighborhood, crossing Cambridge, Princeton and Howell Ave. The path continues along towards the ball field and through the Brush Skatepark turning North onto Hospital Rd and then West up Bunker Hill. Cross the road at the bottom of the hill and run between the golf cart buildings and onto the path East of the golf course. The path will take you North to the Interstate then West along the Interstate and turning back South along the West side of the course to the finish line near the playground.

Plan to run on dirt paths, asphalt, concrete sidewalks and grass. You will get a scenic view of Watrous Park, Sunset Park neighborhood, climb Bunker Hill and run along the beautiful Course at Petteys Park.

Enjoy German beer and pretzels after the race! Proceeds will benefit PolioPlus, Rotary Youth Leadership Awards and Rotary Scholarships.
