



## **Training/Education Reimbursement Program**

### **Objective**

The purpose of this program is to provide businesses within the Brush community expanded professional development opportunities.

### **Eligibility**

All members of the Brush Area Chamber of Commerce as well as all businesses located within the City limits of the City of Brush! and independent contractors that work within chamber businesses (for example: real estate agents that work for a real estate company, insurance agents that work for an insurance company.)

### **Eligible Expenses**

Eligible Expenses include tickets to conferences, seminars, webinars, trainings, and continued education opportunities. This does not include expenses for college courses, but certificate-based programs are allowed.

### **Procedure**

Interested parties simply sign up for their preferred opportunity, submit the receipt and a short narrative to the Chamber Foundation that details the value of the training and if you would recommend it to others.

Upon submittal of the receipt and narrative, the Chamber will reimburse the cost of the opportunity via check to said businesses or if an independent contractor it shall be addressed to individual or business.

Applications are reviewed on a first come first serve basis. The Chamber Foundation has set aside \$2500 in 2025 for this program. Once exhausted, more funds will not be added until 2026. The maximum reimbursement amount will be \$150 per business or individual per calendar year.
